

What support is available for the emotional, mental and social development of pupils with SEN?

The social, emotional and mental health development of your child will be monitored by the Class Teacher on a daily basis, through observation. It is especially vital that parents and school work closely when supporting pupils. We encourage parents to access support and pass on information quickly. When there are on-going areas of concern the school will run a Boxall Screen which will look at all elements of a child's well-being and allow us to target key areas swiftly and with the biggest impact. In addition we also have, playground buddies, small group Circle Time, and social skill groups, for pupils who need support. Access to these supportive strategies does not necessarily mean that your child will be entered on the SEN register.
