Message from the Headteacher

It was good to see you all in school this week for parent/carer consultation meetings with the teaching staff. I hope you found the opportunity to look at your child's workbooks and talk to the staff useful.

Thank you for supporting us with 'Children In Need' – look out for pictures in the East Kent Mercury this week.

The PTFA will be working to secure funds to develop the area in front of classes 5 and 6 and the main entrance. The wooden trim trail has been there for a long time and is due an upgrade and, as most of you will know, the paths are too narrow to cope with the movement of parents, pupils and pushchairs most particularly in the morning rush hour! So, we are looking to develop the area so that it meets the following brief:-

- An inviting focal point to lead visitors to the main entrance of our school,
- Increased hard surfacing and/or wider paths to allow for safe movement of large numbers of people,
- A quieter area for children to use at morning breaks so that Classes 5 and 6 are not too disturbed during their learning time,
