Dear Parent/Carers

Hello and welcome to a new school year. I hope you have all had a good summer. We are looking forward to getting to know all our new families over the coming weeks as well as catching up with all our returning families. I would like to thank you, on behalf of all the staff, for the cards, gifts and best wishes received at the end of last term – they were all very much appreciated.

Thank you also for supporting us with our school uniform; the children all look very smart and ready for learning!

Parent/Teacher Meetings

As you will have seen from the important dates contained in this letter, there are some Parent Teacher meetings coming up for classes 1 - 6. Reception class parents have already had a group meeting and will have individual appointments with the class teacher during the first week. The meetings will take place in the classroom at 2:45pm and are an opportunity to hear about the year ahead including: curriculum, homework/reading, forthcoming trips/special weeks/events, ways to help at home and school, ways to raise concerns and ask questions.

<u>SPORT</u>

We are working to provide ever more sporting opportunities for our pupils with a range of tournaments in a variety of sports being booked for the year. As you know children in classes 1-6 participate in two PE lessons a week, one of these being led by Dominic Castle, our Sports Coach. Over time we have seen ever increasing skill and fitness levels within the children as a result of this provision.

Please support us, and your child, by ensuring they have a full PE kit in school every day. As a minimum, children in classes 1- 6 need a pair of blue shorts, a team coloured T-shirt, a pair of plimsolls for indoor PE and a pair of trainers to work outside. These four items should be at school every day of the week and kept in a suitable draw string bag - **NO** carrier bags please.

We suggest that tracksuit bottoms/joggers and a warm top are brought in for outdoor games during the colder months.

Children in Class R will undertake their physical activities during Terms 1 and 2 in the garden and outside classroom. From Term 3 (January) onwards, the children will begin more formal P.E. lessons in the school hall and will begin to change into their P.E. kits.

READING BOOKS AND HOMEWORK

All children will bring home a reading book and reading contact book by 7th September. Homework will be set during the week beginning 3rd September for all classes. Further information regarding homework and home reading expectations will be shared at the forthcoming parent/teacher meetings for Classes 1-6 (see dates below) and via the class newsletters.

Reception class parent/carers – please ensure you have bought your child a Reading Book Bag which can be purchased from <u>www.pmgschoolwear.co.uk</u>. Remember to use our voucher code **STMCFC** for free delivery. These bags are essential in keeping our stock of reading books in good order.

We recognise that as they move into upper Key Stage 2 children will start to not use a reading book bag and ask, therefore, that parent/carers assist their children in looking after the books.

SAFETY REMINDERS:

<u>Cars</u>

Please may I remind car drivers that **only staff** are permitted to drive onto the school premises between **8:30am and 3:30pm** and those parents who have a prior arrangement with the school due to mobility reasons. Please also be advised that the zig-zag areas outside the school gates are **not to be parked on between 8:30am-9:30am and 2:30pm-4pm**. These measures are in place to protect all members of our school community and your co-operation is anticipated and appreciated.

Play Equipment

Our play equipment in the playground is designed for children between 4 and 11 years old. The children are supervised during the break and lunch times by staff when using it. The equipment is **NOT** to be used by any children before or after school hours, including between 8.35-8.45am when the staff are on duty.

Scooters/Bicycles in the Playground

For the safety of all our children, please would you ensure that your children (including pre-school children) do not ride their scooters or bicycles in the playground of the school at any time.

Morning Routine for Class R

The school day starts at 8:45am, with the classroom door being opened at 8:35am. Please ensure you are punctual. Late arrivals (i.e. after 8:45am) must report to the main school office.

As part of their transition to KS1 the children will begin lining up outside the classroom later on during their Reception year and we will notify you when this change to their routine will start.

Morning Routine for Classes 1 and 2

In Terms 1, 5 and 6 staff from Classes 1 and 2 will come onto the playground from 8.35am and families can gather on the end of the playground by these classrooms. The whistle will be blown at 8.45am for the children to line up and be taken into class by the teachers. Please note that this is NOT a playtime, the playground equipment is not to be used and the children are not to run around.









In Terms 2, 3 and 4 teachers will open their classroom doors between 8:35am and 8:45am for the children to go straight into class.

Children who arrive after 8:45am must enter the school via the main school entrance.

Morning Routine for Classes 3, 4, 5 and 6

Teachers from Classes 3, 4, 5 and 6 will open their classroom doors between 8:35am and 8:45am for the children to go straight into class. Children who arrive after 8:45am must enter school via the main school entrance.

New! Enhanced Parentmail Applications

From now on we will be using two new applications through the ParentMail system. You will now be able to complete forms and give consent/permissions to us online rather than bringing paper into the school office. You will also be able to book your own parents' evening appointments online using your computer, tablet or smartphone.

You will receive confirmation through your ParentMail account once a form or appointment booking goes live. It's all very straight-forward, but if you need help you can visit the ParentMail help site: https://www.parentmail.co.uk/help/parenthelp/

Please note, you will need to be registered on ParentMail to be able to use these applications – if you haven't received a registration email or text, please contact the school office.

Once registered, if you have an Android or Apple smartphone, we would highly recommend you download the ParentMail App so you can complete forms or book appointments on your phone as soon as they go live! To do this, simply search for "ParentMail" in your App store.

As you will know from previous correspondence, holiday during term time <u>will not</u> be authorised and Penalty Notices (a fine) can be issued to parents who take children on holiday during term time.
