We will enjoy learning about...

Our topic this term is 'This is me'. We will be exploring self-portraits in Art as well as finding out the names of different parts of our body and explore our senses in Science. We will also have daily phonics sessions where the children will continue learning their sounds and high frequency words. Our maths lessons will focus on counting, ordering, reading and writing numbers.

We will also learn about the four seasons throughout the year and conduct nature walks around the school to observe changes. Our Geography topic is all about our school environment. Our RE topic this term is 'belonging to a faith community'. Our weekly circle time sessions will focus on 'new beginnings' and 'golden rules'. During our weekly computing lessons we will learn how to log on to the computers and use the mouse and keyboard effectively. In PE the children will take part in Multi-skills sessions with Mr Castle, concentrating on gross and fine motor skills and co-ordination.

Golden Time

Golden Time takes place on a Friday afternoon and is a reward for excellent behaviour in the class. Children may bring in their own toys/games. Please remember that toys can get damaged and even lost in a class environment so please - nothing too valuable or electronic.

Just a Few Things to Remember...
