Message from the Headteacher

What do you know about our After School Childcare Service (ASCS)?

When did the provision start?

This September – it's brand new!

Who runs it?

Mrs Keeley Marconi and Mrs Sarah Morris are the leaders of the ASCS. The office staff take bookings and liaise with the caterers.

What are the timings?

Monday-Friday term time 3.15pm – 5.45pm.

Where does it take place?

The ASCS children and staff have access to all areas within the school building and grounds – they can (and do) use the hall, the playground, the field, the Forest School, the ICT suite and the classrooms. The children are outside as much as is possible depending on the weather and time of year.

What do the children do?

So far they have taken part in art and craft activities, played with toys, car mat and cars, games, puzzles, explored the Forest School and played cricket.

Is there something to eat?

Yes, the school lunch caterers prepare and provide a cold tea for the children – this is buffet style and has items such as pizza, pasta, cheesy puffs, wraps and rolls which the children fill themselves, fruit, vegetable crudites, yoghurt, jelly, cake and biscuits.

How do I book my child(ren) in to attend?

To sign up your child/children to our After-School Childcare Service, please complete a Registration Form (available from the school office). Once registered you may book your child in by using a booking form (also available from the school office) indicating the dates required. Please return the forms to the school office with payment. We are hoping to have an online booking system set up as soon as possible.

How much does it cost?

A session costs £10. If your child attends one of our extra-curricular clubs the £1 fee for this is waived and your child will be taken from the club to the ASCS.
