We will enjoy learning about...

Term 1 – Marvellous Me!

In English we will begin the term by reading various 'Maisy' Books by Lucy Cousins to help us find out about each other, share our life experiences and explore the world around us. We will also share 'Funny Bones' and 'Avocado Baby' to support our topic about the body and keeping healthy. We will be creating stories and writing for a purpose e.g. letters, postcards and instructions. In Science we will be finding out about the human body; investigating the five senses and how to keep healthy. In geography we will be exploring our local area and learning key human and physical features; as well as mapping skills and fieldwork. We will be thinking about our own history and how we have grown. In Art and Design we will create self-portraits, as well providing the opportunity to carry out portraits of our friends, exploring various famous Artists' work to support our developing creativity.

Term 2 – Superheroes

In English we will be reading 'Traction Man', 'Supertato' and 'Percy the Park Keeper'. This will inspire and support our learning about toys from the past, making our own dens/shelter and exploring seasonal change and the weather. Our learning in History will link to our Geography explorations, where we will be finding out about great 'Explorers' of planet Earth (Earth Heroes) for example Mary Anning. In Science and Art and Design we will begin to investigate materials and their properties; which will also support us when deciding on the best materials to use when designing and making our superhero capes and building dens in DT.

Across the Autumn Term, our maths learning will focus on place value within 10/20, counting, ordering, reading and writing numbers. It will include learning about addition and subtraction within 10, shape and measuring height and weight.

In RE we will be finding out about 'who is a Christian and what do they believe?' In PSHE we will be focusing on 'New beginnings' and 'Getting on and falling out.' In ICT we will be look at e safety and uses of IT beyond the home. During our music sessions, we will be exploring pitch and our voices, as well as rehearsing for our Nativity. In P.E. the children will take part in Multiskills sessions with Mr Castle.



Welly Walk Wednesdays

Term 1 and 2 topics include 'Our Local Area', 'Healthy Me' and investigating the weather and seasons. We will be carrying out lots of outdoor learning; where we will explore our forest school, school grounds and St Margaret's village.
