## **English**

#### Reading

- Read accurately by blending sounds
- Read words with very common suffixes
- Read phonics books aloud
- Link reading to own experiences
- Join in with predictable phrases
- Discuss significance of title & events

#### Writing

- Name letters of the alphabet
- Spell very common 'exception' words
- Compose sentences orally before writing

- -To use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.
- -To play tuned and untuned instruments musically.
- -To listen with concentration and understanding to a range of high quality live and recorded music.

#### **Geometry & Measures**

- Measuring length, height, weight and volume

#### **Number/Calculation**

- Count to 100
- Understand Place value with 50
- Read and write numbers to 20
- Use +, and = symbols
- Know number bonds to 20
- Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers within 20, including zero
- Use language, e.g. 'more than', 'most'

## Geography

#### London

- -Name and locate the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas.
- -Use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries.
- -Use aerial photographs and plan perspectives to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features; devise a simple map; and use and construct basic symbols in a key.
