Mathematics	<p><u>Time</u></p> <p>Practice telling the time by playing Hickory Dickory Clock. Carry on trying to tell the time throughout the week on your clocks at home.</p> <p>https://www.ictgames.com/mobilePage/hickoryDickory/</p> 	<p><u>Fractions of a Number</u></p> <p>Collect some pieces of Lego, sticks or another item at home. Divide these between 2, 3 or 4 people or teddy's in your house. For example, I have collected 20 pieces of Lego and I want to find out $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of 20, so I have divided them between myself and my 3 teddy's. Try different amounts. How many does each person or teddy get? Can that number be divided equally? Do they all get an equal amount? Discuss this with an adult.
