<p>Book Club (daily)</p>	<p>Decide on a place and time where you'd like to hold your daily 'Book Club' together – in a den, on the sofa, after lunch, before bedtime. Let your child know that this is a special quiet time just for you to snuggle up and share a picture book together. Encourage and celebrate your child's achievements in reading. Can your child help you to read the story? What tricky words can they find or point out? Can they use their phonics knowledge to help them read along with you? Are there some words they can read without over sounding? Now have a chat about the book – how many stars would you give it? What was your favourite part of the story? Who do you think would enjoy this story? Perhaps you could call them, send them a voice message or text to tell them about it. Happy reading!</p>				

Please remember that activities can be carried out from the screen and/or be adapted and your home learning book used. You do not need to print them out unless you want to. Share your child's learning with them and talk about their answers together.
