This is a Pick 'n' Mix grid, which has a variety of fun activities on which you might like to do. You do not have to do any of these but thought it would be nice to give you a choice of some extra activities if you would like to do them.

<p><b>Sock Puppet</b></p> <p>If you have an old sock, you could make a sock puppet. How many different types of materials can you use to make it? Draw a picture of your finished sock puppet and label all the different types of materials you used (plastic, paper, fabric etc).</p>	<p><b>A Whole New World</b></p> <p>In Geography we have previously learnt about the continents of the world. Create your own world on a piece of paper or make a model of it.</p> <p>What would your world look like? What makes you happy?</p> <p>Make a poster or collage to show the things that make you happy.</p>

<p><b>Famous!</b></p> <p>In Topic last term, we were learning about Florence Nightingale, who was a famous person. Imagine you are famous. What are you famous for? Draw a picture of yourself and write a caption to tell us all about you.</p>	<p><b>Be Kind</b></p> <p>Make a poster showing different ways we can be kind to other people. This could be family members or other children when we are at school.</p>	<p><b>Rainbow Scavenger Hunt</b></p> <p>Collect as many items as you can, from around your home, that are the colours of the rainbow. Layout them out to make your own rainbow. Take a photo if you can.</p>
