





Alternatively, re-tell the Three Billy Goats Story. Use the ideas in the story to recreate some of these movements, find a safe space first. Can you make a balance shaped like a Billy Goat? Can you make your body into a bridge shape and hold this balance?

...all children should be able to:

- show a star, straight and tuck shape with their body and hold it still;
- choose two contrasting balances with support and perform them;
- copy the movements of others to travel and balance in different ways;
- create a simple sequence with support, repeating movements if necessary;
- · perform a log or egg roll with some control;
- · perform a straight jump and land safely;

Do you recognise any of these characters from the stories that you are going to use?

What do you know about this story? What do you notice about the size of each goat?

Can you make these shapes with your body? Are you making a clear shape?

Are you holding your body still?

Can you balance on your tiptoes in a star shape? Can you lift one leg?

Can you balance on your tiptoes in a straight shape?

Can you lift one leg into an interesting position?

Can you create a tucked shape on another part of your body?

Can you move like the medium-sized goat?

Did you name each shape correctly? Which word would you match to each balance?



Friday – History – Victorian Toys – look at this picture. Discuss the toys you can see. Have you seen any of them before? What do you think they are? How would you play with them? Which one would like to play?
