


# St Margaret's at Cliffe Curriculum Overview for Year 1 Term 4 2022 - 2023

## English


### Reading:

- Read accurately by blending sounds.
- Read words with very common suffixes.
- Link reading to own experiences.
- Join in with predictable phrases.
- Discuss significance of title & events.



### Writing:

- Spell common 'exception' (tricky) words.
- Compose sentences orally before writing.
- Read own writing to peers or teachers.



### Grammar:

- Leave spaces between words.
- Use basic punctuation: . ? !
- Use capital letters for proper nouns.


### Speaking and Listening:

- Listen & respond appropriately.
- Ask relevant questions.
- Maintain attention & participate.

## Mathematics

### Place value numbers to 50:

- Count from 20-50.
- Read & write numbers to 50.
- Represent numbers to 50 using tens and ones.
- The number line up to 50.
- Identify 'one more' and 'one less' with numbers to 50..




### Length and height:

- Comparing lengths and heights.
- Measuring length using objects.
- Measuring length using cm.

### Weight and volume:

- Heavier and lighter.
- Measuring and comparing mass.
- Full and empty.
- Comparing volume.
- Measuring and comparing capacity.

### Working Scientifically

- Observing closely.
- Identifying and classifying.

### Animals including humans

- Identify and name a variety of common animals including, fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.
- Identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
- Describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals including pets).



### Seasonal Changes

- Observe the changes and weather associated with the springtime.



## Religious Education

### What makes some places sacred?

- Identify special objects and symbols found in a place where people worship.
- How and why do we celebrate special and sacred times?



## Music

### History of Music – Seasons and Weather

- Singing and performing.
- History of Music linked to Seasons and Weather.



## Geography

### Maps – Where is our school?


- Draw simple maps and plans with symbols.

### Dance and Multi-skills

- Develop balance, agility and co-ordination, and apply these in a range of dance activities.
- Master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching.
