Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to your child's final two terms at St Margaret's at Cliffe Primary School. We are focusing on our maths and English learning over the next few weeks before we sit our SATs tests in the week beginning Monday 8th May. The children have worked very hard to ensure they are familiar with the test format and that they are ready to sit these tests.

Please note that Monday 8th May is now a Bank Holiday – as a result, the SATS tests will now take place as follows:
Tuesday 9th May – Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (2 papers)
Wednesday 10th May – Reading (1 paper)
Thursday 11th May – Maths (2 papers)
Friday 12th May – (1 paper)

After the SATs, we can begin looking into lots of the exciting opportunities that the end of year 6 brings. We will be beginning to work on our end of year production, to be performed at the Village Hall on Thursday 13th July at 6pm.

Throughout term 6, the secondary schools usually send a member of their team here for an informal visit to talk to the children. This is a good way for the children to meet a friendly face and to ask any questions they may have about their new schools.

Year six staff are busy finalising plans to be able to give your children a memorable final term and the send-off they deserve into their secondary school lives. Please look out for further details coming in the next few weeks about our plans.
