I would like to take this opportunity to extend huge thanks to all members of our school community – children, families, staff and governors – who have all worked together so successfully during this last year. The staff have all been brilliant – working tirelessly, always with the best interests of the children at heart.

Looking Forward

We will be holding staff training days on Friday, 1st and Monday, 4th September. Children in all classes return to school on **Tuesday**, 5th **September** for the beginning of Term 1.

Drop-off arrangements will continue to be as follows:-

The three gates to access the playground will open at **8.35am**. Classroom doors will open at this time also and children will go straight into class. Children must arrive by **8.45am**. Parent/carers may bring children onto the playground. Please note this slight change of time – we have reverted back to pre-pandemic timings.









Collection Arrangements:-

All classes will be dismissed at 3.15pm. The three gates to the playground will be open from 3.05pm. Please come on site and stay on the playground in an area outside your child's classroom. Parent/carers collecting children from Classes 3 and 4 should wait in the area outside their classroom doors. When the staff can see you and have had eye contact with you they will send your child to you.

Before School and After School Childcare Services

These will resume from Tuesday, 5th September – has been sent out with regards making bookings.

School Meals

All children in Classes R, 1 and 2 will continue to be entitled to a free cooked school lunch every day and these are highly recommended.

Children in our current Class 2 who have benefited from the free cooked lunch will, from September when they join Class 3, pay for their cooked school lunches with children in Classes 4, 5 and 6 unless they are entitled to means tested Free School Meals. If you need help to apply for Means Tested Free School Meals please contact the school office.

The cost of a school dinner in September will be £2.41. **Please note** that payment online direct to Whole School Meals is the only method for payment. To pay online use the following link https://www.parentpayshop.co.uk/schools/wsm/. Cash/cheques will not be accepted.

PE Kits

From the beginning of the new term in September children in classes 1-6 will need to bring a PE kit to school. This should be in a draw-string bag which they will keep on their peg. **No carrier bags please**. Reception Class will only need plimsolls in a draw-string bag. Once the term begins teachers will let you know which days each class has PE.

Pierced Ears

Children <u>cannot</u> wear ear-rings during PE. If you are thinking of getting your child's ears pierced please do so at the beginning of the school summer holiday so they have time to heal in order for them to take their ear-rings out for PE lessons at school. Thank you for your support with this.

Water Bottles

Please send in a water bottle every day with fresh water. Children may bring an additional flavoured drink to have at lunchtime, but must drink water only during lesson time.
