Class 4 have had a busy first few weeks back at school in which we have painted Roman shields, learnt about phishing with Bob, begun to learn a Roman song, found out about Mrs Gren, and even fractured our portraits! In English, we have used picture mapping and acted out an explanation text about How a Jellyfish Stings, which we are using as our model to write about How a Spider Catches its Prey. We have learnt lots of new scientific words, such as 'nematocysts'!

Our maths has focussed on the place value of each digit within a 4-digit number. We have learnt how to flexibly partition them, place them on a number line and find more or less. We have also started practising our times tables which are really important this year — please keep practising them at home on Timestables Rockstars.
