Message from Class 1

This term, Class 1 have done brilliantly settling into their new learning environment. They have learned the new rules and routines and they are very keen with their learning.

In science, we have been learning about the human body. We have been learning the names of the body parts and labelling them. We learned about our 5 senses and learned the parts of the body that we use for each of them.

This week in English, the children have been exploring poetry. We have used our senses to talk about the things we enjoy in the autumn - crunchy leaves, smoky bonfires, and delicious hot chocolate! We have shared a Roger McGough poem 'The Sound Collector' and looked for words that rhyme in poems.

In maths, we have been practising our numbers to 10 making sure we are really secure with them and that we can count forwards and backwards from any number. This week we are learning about the greater than and less than signs and using them to compare numbers.

We would also like to mention how much we enjoyed taking the class to the lighthouse for our visit last week. The children were well behaved and listened so well to the helpers – we learned so much about The South Foreland Lighthouse.
