English

Reading:

- Read accurately by blending sounds

Writing and Composition:

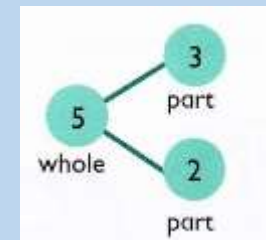
- Write sentences by saying out loud what they are going to write about

Mathematics

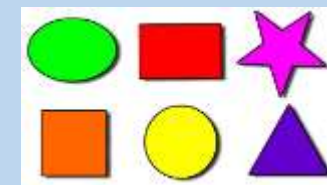
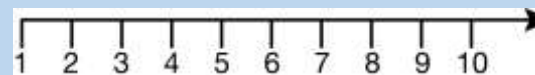
Addition and Subtraction:
