Thursday 16th May – Maths (1 paper)

After the SATs, we can begin looking into lots of the exciting opportunities that the end of year 6 brings. We will be beginning to work on our end of year production, to be performed at the Village Hall on Friday 12th July at 6pm.

Throughout term 6, the secondary schools usually send a member of their team here for an informal visit to talk to the children. This is a good way for the children to meet a friendly face and to ask any questions they may have about their new schools.
