**The Wolf Wilder**, by Katherine Rundell, centres around Feo, who lives in the Russian woods and teaches tamed wolves how to survive in the wild. ### Learning Overview Terms 3 & 4 2024/25

## History / Geography

In the **Frozen Kingdoms** project, we will learn about the regions of the Arctic and Antarctic. We will find out about the similarities and differences between these two regions, including the climate, landscape and natural resources. We will learn about the indigenous people of the Arctic, including how their lives have changed over time, and about the positives and negatives of tourism in Antarctica.

## Science - Electrical Circuits, Light

In our **Electrical Circuits and Components** project, we will make a range of circuits, using symbols to draw circuit diagrams. We will also observe how **Light** travels in straight lines and discover what happens to light when it enters the eye.

## Computing - Spreadsheets, Blogging

By using software, children will learn to use a **Spreadsheet** package, including formula, charts and real-life problems. Our **Blogging** unit is designed to help us learn the basic principles of creating and maintaining a blog in a safe environment.

## Art & Design - Environmental Artists

In this project, we will learn about the genre of environmental art. We study how artists create artwork that addresses social and political issues related to the natural and urban environment. We will work collaboratively to create artwork.

## Music – Film, Theme & Variations

We will identify the characteristics of **Film Music**, creating a composition to perform alongside a film. We will also explore the musical concept of theme and variations.
