#### **Swimming**

Swimming lessons for our Year 4 children commenced on Tuesday afternoon. We are grateful to the staff at the St Margaret's Bay Caravan Park for allowing us to use the pool and facilities.

By the end of Key Stage 2 children should be able to swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres; use a range of strokes effectively and perform a safe self-rescue.

Swimming lessons are part of our core curriculum offer in Years 3 and 4. We offer additional lessons to pupils in Year 5 and 6 who are yet to achieve the measures outlined above.
