We have lots of exciting learning opportunities planned for the children this term; all based around the themes of Kings and Queens, Plants and the Seaside. We are looking forward to a wonderful term full of learning, challenge and fun!

We will enjoy learning about...

During our English lessons we will be reading the story, 'Zog' by Julia Donaldson and our final topic in term 6 is 'Once Upon a Time' where we will focus on Traditional Tales. The children will continue to have a daily phonics session where they will be learning alternative pronunciations and reading real and nonsense words. The children will be challenged further in maths over the next two terms and will be learning about money, time, addition/subtraction problems, place value and measurement. Our Science topic is all about 'Plants'. Some of the activities will include labeling parts of a plant, identifying common plants in the wild and describing the difference between deciduous and evergreen. In History our themes are 'Kings and Queens' and 'The Seaside'. In DT the children will be designing and making a castle and creating rainbow lollipops. Mr Castle will continue working with us during our PE sessions. We will also be taking part in athletics and will be using our skills to play team games. In PSHE we will focus on 'Friendships', 'Changes' in our lives; as well as preparing the children for Class 2.

Welly Walk Wednesdays

As our topics include 'Plants' and 'The Seaside' we will be carrying out lots of outdoor learning. We will explore and develop our own outdoor space, school grounds and Forest School.
