Message from the Headteacher

Happy new school year to you all; welcome to our new families and welcome back to our regulars.

The children have settled quickly to the routine of being at school and look smart and ready to learn in their uniforms; thank you for your support with this.

Parent/Teacher Meetings

You will have noticed from the welcome letter sent home on Wednesday that we have hosted parent/teacher meetings this week and will continue to next week. These are an opportunity for you to meet in the classroom with the other parents and the class teacher and to hear about what your child will be doing at school and ways in which you can help. The dates are included below for your reference.

Staff Training

At the beginning of the week we all received training in the use of 'Numicon', a multi-sensory mathematics teaching programme using visual Numicon images in a series of practical teaching activities. When Numicon patterns are arranged in order, pupils begin to notice important connections between numbers for instance that each number is one more than the last and one fewer than the next, odd and even numbers and place value. Numicon illustrates number bonds, addition and subtraction, place value, doubling and halving, estimation, division and multiplication.

The children and staff have already started using these new resources and you may see them in class when you are next in school. Hopefully your child will be able to tell you something about it too!
