For example, An ice cream costs 2p. Candyfloss costs 5p.




You could also play the toy shop game online.

Design a new luxury tank for the Singing Mermaid to live in while she worked in the circus.

Build a model of the circus tent. What materials will you need to use?

The pages all have glitter on them. Can you make a piece of artwork that uses glitter to make things shine?

A mermaid is half human with a fish's tail. Can you create a creature that is a mixture of two or more animals?

<u>Science</u>

The story Singing Mermaid sings to a number of different types of fish and sea creatures.

Can you find out the names of anymore fish or sea creatures? Discuss with an adult how are they similar and how are they different?



You might even like to do some Geography and find out which types of fish live in what oceans.

The acrobats in The Singing Mermaid have to practice their balancing skills. Here are a couple of balancing activities for you to try.
