Maths challenge: Roll dice to create ten 4 or 5 digit numbers including two decimal places. Choose two of your numbers. Estimate their sum/ total- write your estimate down. Now add your numbers together using the method you learnt this week. Check your answer with a calculator. How close was your estimate? Repeat until you feel confident estimating and finding the sum of two decimal numbers.
