when help is needed



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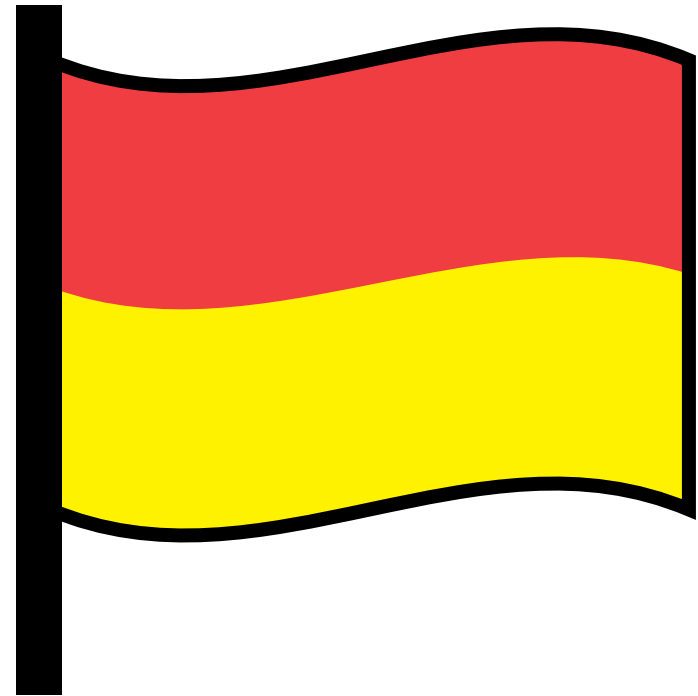

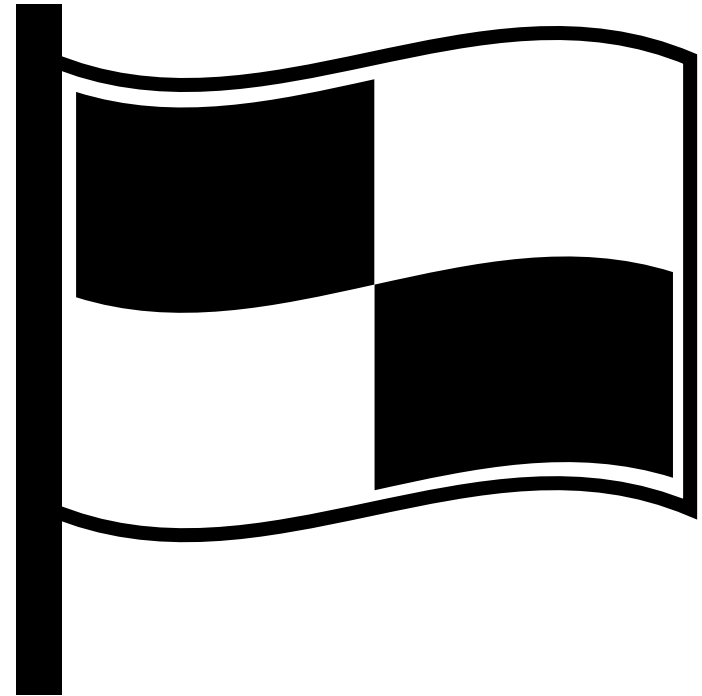
This shows the lifeguarded area and is the safest place to swim and bodyboard

NOT swim here**



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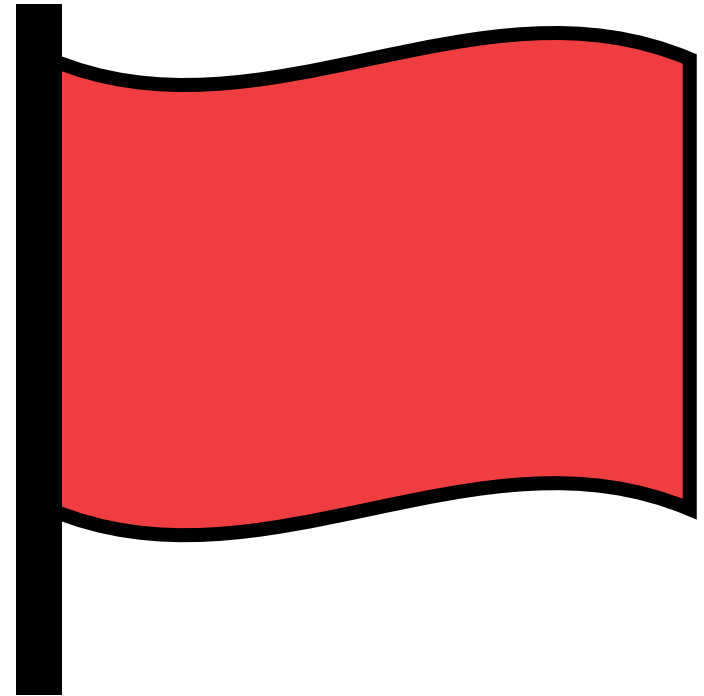


Lifeboats

Danger! Never go in the water under any circumstances when the red flag is flying

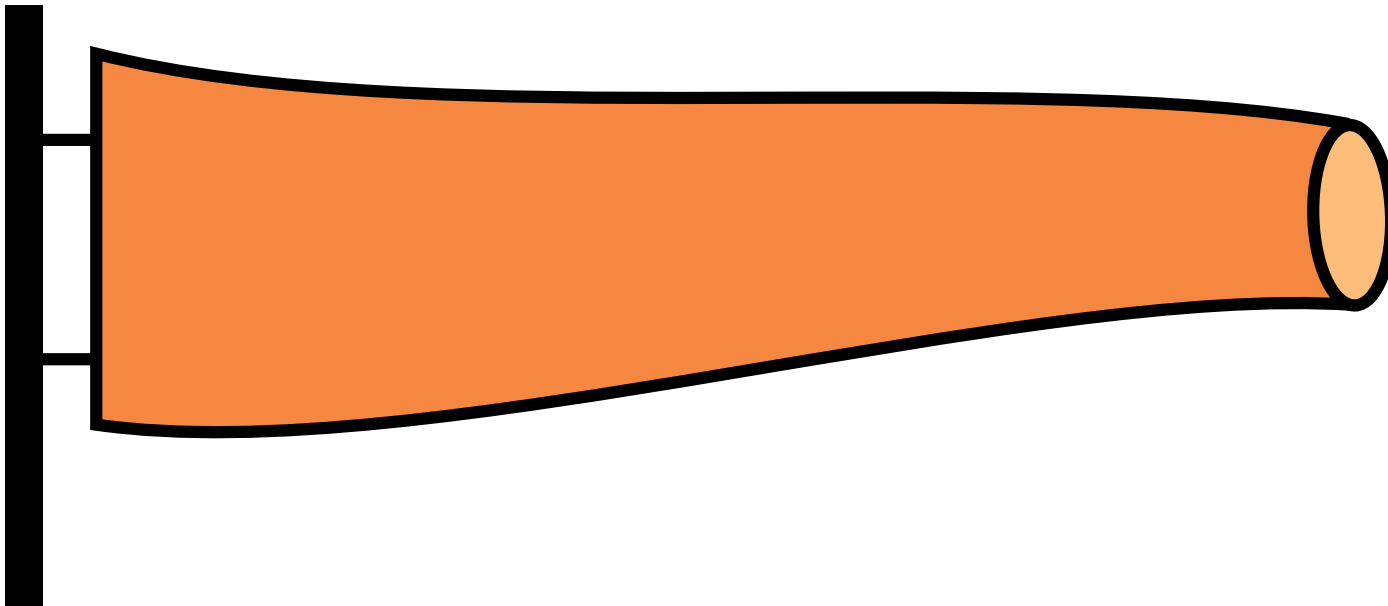
It is put up for many reasons but is mostly likely to be flown in bad weather such as fog and lightning

When this flag is flying you should NOT go in the water



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This means never use inflatables when it is windy



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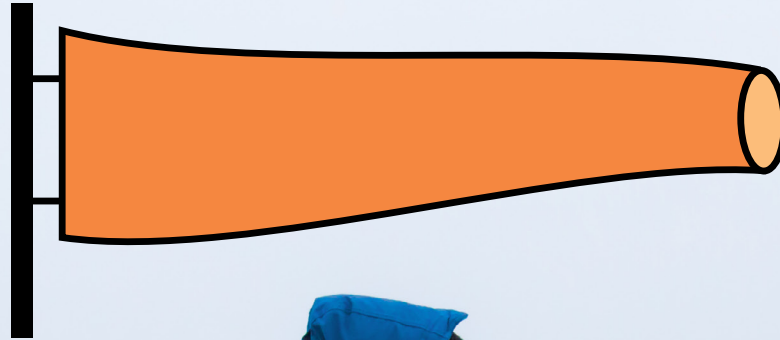
Which flag might you see on this beach?

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The red and yellow flags: lifeguards use two red and yellow flags to mark the safest area to swim and bodyboard

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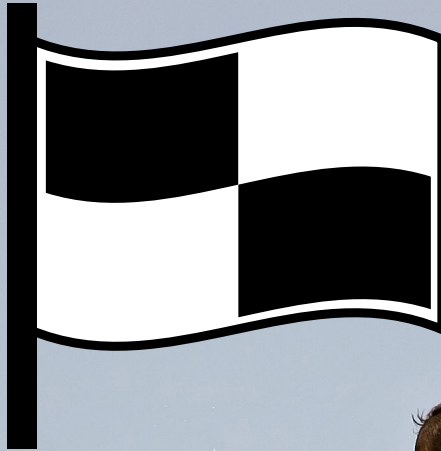
