What we are learning in Term 1...

Getting to know you!

This term we will be establishing our new routines and exploring our new learning environment together. We will be finding out about our senses and naming our body parts. We will be exploring materials around us and begin making maps, as we explore the place where we live. We will have the opportunity to learn new skills in our P.E. sessions with Mr. Castle, including beginning to play tag rugby.

What we are learning in Term 2. . .

Exploring our world

During term 2 we will be continuing to develop our reading and writing, exploring different opportunities for writing, including cards, invitations and letters. We will extend our mathematical understanding by working with numbers to 20 and beyond.

We will be investigating different types of puppets and will be making some of our own!

We will develop our drawing and painting skills and will study some famous artists, Paul Klee and Joan Miro. We will develop our historical understanding of famous events by learning about The Gunpowder Plot!

In our P.E. lessons we will begin to learn some simple dance moves and routines.
