RESULTS*

**Please note that SATS did not take place Summer 2020 so current results are still from Summer 2019.*

We are very proud to be able to tell you that:-

- By the end of Reception class in 2019 89% of the children had achieved the expected 'Good Level of Development' standard — this compares most favourably to the national picture of 72%.
- Achievement at the end of Key Stage 1 and end of Key Stage 2 continues to be very high with results in reading, writing and maths securely above national averages.
- Typically between 65% to 70% of pupils transfer to a Grammar School from St. Margaret's-at-Cliffe Primary School.
- OFSTED judges our school to be an **outstanding** school; 22% of schools in Kent are currently judged as outstanding.

These excellent results give a clear indication of how the needs of all of our pupils are being met.
