- Fun facts


Just like a story map, you should draw pictures, write some words and draw arrows to link information.

- Bullet points for listed information
- A picture or photograph with a caption
- A question to the reader Have you ever seen a pig in real life?
- Writing in the present tense: Pigs live in, they eat, they can be found....
