We hope you all had a lovely Easter break and would like to take the opportunity to welcome you and your children back to school for their final 2 terms in the Reception class – can you believe it!


We are pleased to welcome Miss Quain to our Early Years team this term.


We are looking forward to another term of adventures with the children.

We will enjoy learning about... Term 5 – Once upon a time

This term will focus on traditional tales. We will be starting with Jack and the Beanstalk, reading and learning the pattern of the story. We will be creative with painting beanstalks and planting seeds. We will also be learning about the traditional tales of: Cinderella and Little Red Riding Hood. We will listen to the traditional 'Once upon a time' story words and think about which characters are good and which are bad. We will practise using our phonic knowledge of sounds to write some words and sentences from the stories.











Term 6 – Outdoor Explorers

Next term we will be enjoying the great outdoors! We will become explorers of our environment, hunting and examining plants and mini beasts. We will read non-fiction books about creepy crawlies and write captions to describe how they are different. We will investigate their habitats in our garden and in Forest School.
