Spellings	This week visit spelling play to practise your different spelling skills. You may also like to use the spelling strategies on the class home learning page to help you.				
English	WALT: be able to participate in drama and role play We will share the story of The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch. We will make puppets and props to retell the story.	WALT: write a poem about the seaside We will read poems about the seaside together. We will then write our own. Can you write a poem about the seaside. Think about what you can see, taste, hear, think and smell.	BEACH DAY! Today we will be bringing the beach to the classroom! We will set up lots of fun activities for the children to explore. Can you draw and write about your experiences at the beach?	WALT: write for a purpose (postcard) We will write a postcard about our day at 'the beach' yesterday.	WALT: read and talk about a story In school we will share some beach themed stories. We will choose our favourite story and make puppets and props to retell the story to our friends. Maths Starter:	WALT: recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. <i>visit TT Rock stars and practise your 2, 5 and 10 times tables for 5 minutes EVERYDAY this week.</i> 				
Maths	WALT: beginning to record the addition of 2 2-digit numbers in a vertical format. We will continue to learn about the vertical format.	WALT: select coins to pay We will create an icecream van menu. We will find the correct coins to pay for our lollypops. Can you create your own menu and pay for items at home?	WALT: to select equipment to measure We will enjoy playing in the water tray – measuring water (ml/kl) and other objects we might find on the beach (cms) e.g. shells and rocks.	WALT: create and follow instructions using position and direction vocabulary We will create and follow directions to find the hidden treasure. Can you set up a treasure hunt in your garden?	WALT: create and follow instructions using position and direction vocabulary Follow the directions to find the different seaside objects.
Foundation subject	Art and Design WALT: create a print, collage or painting In school we will be joining in a Printing Workshop with Jenny Preston, a local artist. We will be looking at natural and physical features around St Margaret's Bay and Deal to inspire us. At home create a piece of art work of a favourite seaside place.	Design Technology WALT: use a range of materials and components, including construction materials and kits, and mechanical components We will design and create a model of a lighthouse. We will also explore making a pulley system for delivering a picnic from The Lighthouse Keeper's house to the lighthouse.	Science WALT: record results We will record what happened to the plants from last week's experiment and discuss if our predictions were correct.	P.E WALT: throw a variety of objects for accuracy and distance In school we will set up a beach themed sports event. Can you go for a walk along the beach? Or choose some of your favourite activities from this term?
