Coronavirus Symptoms

Children or staff with <u>any</u> of the three symptoms of Covid:

- a new continuous cough;
- a fever;
- a change in taste or smell are to <u>stay at home</u> and isolate, as must the rest of their household.
 They should get a Covid test.
 Children and staff must also stay at home and isolate if a <u>member of their</u> <u>household</u> has any of these symptoms until the outcome of a Covid test is known and follow advice accordingly.
