It has been lovely to welcome the children back and hear all about the fun they have had over the holidays!

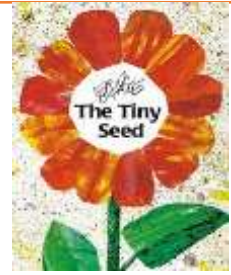
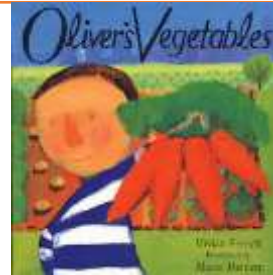
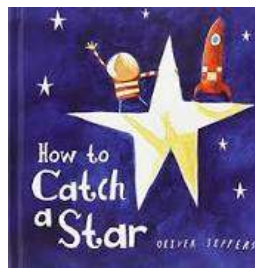
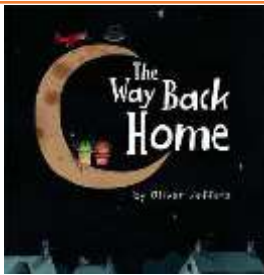
Thank you for all our wonderful Christmas gifts. You have been very kind and generous.
