Phonics and Reading

In phonics we will be learning new phonemes (sounds) from Phase 5 as we continue to use our new phonic reading sceheme – Little Wandle. We have included a Phase 5 sound mat in the children's Home Learning Books. Please use this to practise new sounds with your child.

A gentle reminder – we ask that a parent or carer reads with the children in Year 1 everyday for a short time. This consistent practise really is the best way to ensure that new skills are being used and that reading improves quickly.
