Message from the Headteacher

Kent Test registration for Year 5 pupils

Registration for the Kent Test, for children due to start secondary school in September 2024, will close at midnight on Monday, 3rd July 2023. If you would like to register your child and haven't done so yet please make sure you register by the deadline as they will not accept late registrations.

NEU Strike Action Wednesday 5th and Friday 7th July 2023

The National Education Union are undertaking further strike action next week. Most teachers have informed me of their intentions and I can confirm that on **Wednesday 5th July Classes R, 1, 3 and 6 will be closed so children in these classes are not to attend school**.
