## English

### Spoken Language

- Master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching
- Developing balance, agility and co-ordination
- Show control and coordination when travelling
- Choose and link actions
- Find and use space safely, with an awareness of others



## Mathematics

### Number and place value

- Count reliably with numbers from one to 10, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number. Using quantities and objects add and subtract two singledigit numbers and count on or back to find the answer.
- Solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.
- Count, read and write numbers to 10 in numerals
- Identify one more and one less of a given number

### Addition and Subtraction

- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition, subtraction and equals sign
