New Learning

During our science topic of 'Animals including Humans', the children will be encouraged to be curious and ask questions. The topic will include: noticing how animals have offspring which grow into adults, describing the basic needs for animals including water and food and describing the importance of human exercise and hygiene. This is always a very exciting topic and the children enjoy talking about their favourite animals!

Our art topic is 'colours and emotions' where we will be experimenting with water colours and paints to express different moods. We will be taking inspiration from Van Gogh.



School Trips

During Term 3, we have two very exciting school trips. The first is on Wednesday 10th January where we will be exploring the town of Dover including a visit to the Museum. In addition to this, we will be walking around St Margaret's on Monday 15th January comparing the village to the town of Dover.

We will be exploring different features of a town and village including the number of shops, number of cars and any different landmarks. We will complete different activities based on our findings!

Reading

During Terms 3 and 4, we will continue our guided reading sessions. It is really important that we have your child's reading record in school every day so we are able to record all their fantastic reading. We do offer the children house points as an incentive for bringing in their reading records! Your child will bring their guided reading book home on a Friday along with a book of their choice. Please can we ask that both these books are returned on a Thursday so that the children can choose a new book. Thank you for your understanding.
