Writing:

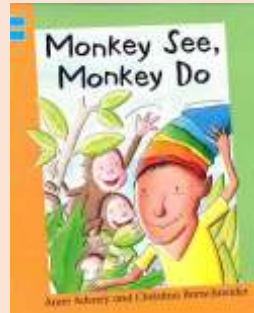
- Spell common 'exception' (tricky) words

Speaking and Listening:

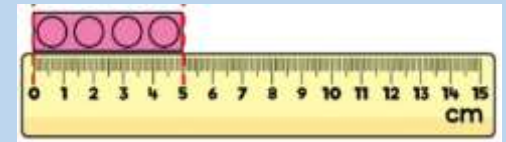
- Listen & respond appropriately

- Count from 20-50
- Read & write numbers to 50
- Count by making groups of tens and ones
- Represent numbers to 50 using tens and ones

- Identify 'one more' and 'one less' with numbers to 50

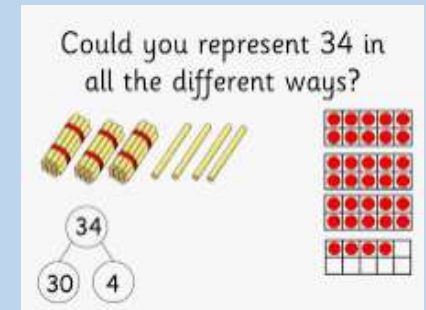


Length and height:
