

English:

Non-Chronological and newspaper reports, calligram poems and diary entries

We will be exploring, then writing our own, of each text type. We will also be reading *The Firework Maker's Daughter* by Phillip Pullman.

DT: Making it move

The children will design, make and evaluate a child's automaton toy.

RE: Religious festivals

The children will explore the significance of festivals to religious communities and consider how people of different beliefs celebrate them.

PSHE: Dreams and Goals, Healthy Me

These topics involve setting and mapping out goals and learning about how to stay healthy.

PE: Gym, Dance, Cricket, Swimming

The children will develop their flexibility, control, balance and technique across each sport.

Maths:

Money, Statistics, Shape, Fractions

This will include: counting money and giving change; drawing and interpreting represented data; recognising and drawing shapes; and adding, subtracting and comparing fractions.

Terms 3 & 4 2024/25

Geography:

Rocks, Relics and Rumbles

This project teaches children about the features and characteristics of Earth's layers, including a detailed exploration of volcanic, tectonic and seismic activity.

Science:

Light and Shadows, Plants

These projects teach children about: light, dark, reflections and shadows; and the requirements of plants for growth and survival.

Computing:

Touch-typing, Email and Databases

The children will: learn how to sit at and use a keyboard; learn to use email safely; and be introduced to databases.

Art & Design: Ammonite

This project teaches children about artistic techniques used in sketching, printmaking and sculpture.

Music: Ballads and Caribbean Music

The children will explore and perform both genres of music, using percussion instruments in their Caribbean music.
