The ability to chat with strangers online presents a serious safeguarding risk, and we urge all parents and carers to be vigilant and to check the security settings on any apps or games your child is using. This particular platform has been in the news quite a bit recently.

We will continue to reinforce online safety messages at school, but your support at home is vital in helping children develop safe and responsible online habits.
