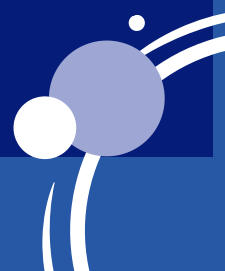
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FEATURES

ACHIEVEMENT

By the end of the Reception class in 2025, 71.5% of our children reached the expected 'Good Level of Development' standard, surpassing the national average of 69%.

Phonics results at the end of Year 1 show 89% of our children met the expected standard for a child in Year 1.

Typically, 65% to 70% of students move on to Grammar School from St Margaret's-at-Cliffe Primary School.
